ORDINANCE NO. 1103-012020

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 2.33 POLICE DEPARTMENT,
OF TITLE 2, ADMINISTRATION AND PERSONNEL OF THE OGLESBY CITY CODE

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the City of Oglesby have decided that it is in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Oglesby to provide that the Mayor, with the approval and consent of the City Council, has the power to appoint the Chief of Police for the City of Oglesby; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-5-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/4-5-2) provides that the Oglesby City Council, by ordinance, shall determine the powers of and the duties to be performed by each department and shall assign them to the appropriate departments and may make such rules and regulations as may be necessary or proper for the efficient and economical conduct of the business of the municipality; and

WHEREAS, Section 4-5-5 of the Illinois Municipal Code (65 ILCS 5/11-4-5-5) provides that the Oglesby City Council has the right and power to appoint and discharge the heads of all principal departments subordinate to the departments provided for in Section 4-5-2 of the Illinois Municipal Code; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Commissioners of the City of Oglesby deem it to be in the best interest of the public health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Oglesby to amend the Oglesby City Code to provide for the appointment of the Chief of Police by the Mayor of the City of Oglesby, subject to the advise and consent of the Oglesby City Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND COMMISSIONERS OF THE CITY OF OGLESBY, LASALLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

1. The recitals contained in the preamble to this ordinance are incorporated by reference as if set out in full herein.

2. Section 2.33.070 of the Oglesby City Code shall be repealed in its entirety and replaced with the following Section 2.33.070:

2.33.070 Chief of police - Appointment

Whenever a vacancy occurs in the office of Chief of Police in the City of Oglesby, the Mayor of the City of Oglesby shall nominate an individual to serve as Oglesby Chief of Police and, if the Oglesby City Council approves the Mayor's nominee, the Oglesby City Council shall appoint the Mayor's nominee as Chief of Police.

3. All the remaining provisions of Chapter 2.33, Police Department, of Title 2, Administration and Personnel not otherwise amended by this ordinance shall remain in full force and effect.

4. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect from and after its passage, approval and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
